



Users manual for the SIWA

The SIWA (Stereo in-wall amplifier) is an amplifier designed to fit in a single gang slot in a wall. Usage of this amplifier is very simple. Just plug in the ***power supply*** or the unit, connect the SIWA to its ***source*** via the left & right ***RCA jacks***. Then hook up your speakers via the ***speaker wires*** located on the back of the SIWA unit.

Please refer to the attached SIWA diagram.

The wiring of the amplifier is color-coded. The blue wire is the right positive, the black wire is the right negative. The white wire is the left positive the brown wire is the left negative. Please make sure to hook up the wires correctly in order to have the sound coming from the correct speakers and to prevent a short in the system. Once the speakers are connected to a source you can plug in the power with the included power supply.

When installing the system, place the amplifier inside of a *plastic box*, not a metal box, since installing the amplifier in a metal box can create a short in the system.

You are now ready to enjoy music or any other audio for your SIWA amplifier.
